PBG Builders Honored by Tennessee Concrete Association

Nashville, TN – PBG Builders, Inc. of Goodlettsville was presented the Tennessee Concrete Association Best Specialty Concrete Project Award at the Tennessee Concrete Association (TCA) Annual Convention in Nashville.

The TCA Best Specialty Concrete Project Award was presented to PBG for its innovative approach to constructing the new elevator towers at LP Field.

The “LP Field Fan Enhancement Project” involved the construction of two new one hundred feet tall cast-in-place concrete elevator towers, which added twelve elevators for the upper concourse. Because LP Field is a public-owned facility, durability and low maintenance were key considerations. The construction, from digging the foundation to topping out, had to be completed within thirty days. Self-consolidating concrete along with a unique climbing formwork system were used, allowing the towers to be completed ahead of schedule, fit the aesthetics of LP Field, and be under budget. PBG Builders’ team on the project included subcontractor Charter Construction, Inc. and supplier Irving Materials, Inc. (imi).

This award is the most recent honor recognizing PBG Builders for excellence. PBG Builders was recognized by Associated General Contractors of Tennessee (AGC), Middle Tennessee Branch as the 2013 General Contractor of the year and won four awards for its projects, including one for the LP Field Fan Enhancement project. PBG was also named General Contractor of the Year by AGC in 2011.
